Sonja Maria Steckbauer is visiting professor at the University of Graz (Austria), and teaching at the Universities of Erlangen-Nürnberg and Passau (Germany) as well.

Studies at the University of Salzburg (Austria) and the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Lima (Peru); Ph.D. at the University of Salzburg (1990); Habilitation (Post-doc) at the Catholic University of Eichstätt-Ingolstadt (2002).

She has been invited to collaborate at different universities: Universities of Salzburg and Innsbruck (Austria), FU Berlin, and Eberhard-Karls-Universität Tübingen (Germany), Coimbra (Portugal), Guadalajara (Mexico).

Her investigation is focussed on Latin American (Hispanic and Brazilian) literatures - especially Peru, Mexico, Paraguay - as well as French Canadian literature.
